Vince said he called on my personal telephone on Saturday evening. She said wondering what you guys thought about our former mayor. She said heard he was set up. She said that is entrapment. She said sheriff in Lima suppose to call her because she knows some things. Vince said you should be on our side and I don't think you are. Barb said it should have never happened, Vince said it is a lot safer. Barb said road was widened to benefit the factories at Leipsic, Vince said the factories don't care, it is for safety. She said talked to people from Leipsic hate smell because of factories. Barb said I care about safety because my son got killed. She said the former sheriff is out of office because of a lot of shady things. She said I decided to support these people and Vince said you are wrong. Vince said it is safer. Barb said the greedy generation and that is why we are getting sued Vince said. She said people should have been able to vote for it. Vince said I don't want people getting killed because of the road not being wide enough.
